Mark 13:20-23 NET

“And if the Lord had not cut short those days, no one would be saved. But because of the elect, whom he chose, he has cut them short.
²¹ Then if anyone says to you, ‘Look, here is the Christ!’ or ‘Look, there he is!’ do not believe him. ²² For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and perform signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, the elect.
²³ Be careful! I have told you everything ahead of time.”



Mark 13:24-27 ^{NET}

“But in those days, after that suffering, the sun will be darkened and the moon will not give its light; ²⁵ the stars will be falling from heaven, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. ²⁶ **Then everyone will see the Son of Man arriving in the clouds with great power and glory.** ²⁷ Then he will send angels and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven.”

Suffering Servant - Mark 8-10

Defeat sin and death

“Seek and save the lost” - Mark 10:45

2nd Advent

Visible, clear, powerful, global

Saving Sovereign - Mark 13

Establish the Kingdom fully and finally

“Gather His own” - Mark 13:27

Mark 13:28-32 ^{NET}

“Learn this parable from the fig tree: Whenever its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves, you know that summer is near. ²⁹ So also you, when you see these things happening, **know that he is near, right at the door.** ³⁰ I tell you the truth, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. ³¹ Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away. ³² “But **as for that day or hour no one knows** it - neither the angels in heaven, nor the Son - except the Father.”




